New Faculty Steering Committee Named

This December, Babson's Vikki Rodgers, Wellesley's Ted Ducas, and Olin's Jean Huang have been named to the Collaboration's Joint Faculty Steering committee.

The Joint Faculty Steering Committee is the driving force of the Collaboration. The overall charge of the Committee is to broaden and deepen interest among the community in the Collaboration. The Committee has a high level of autonomy to experiment and innovate.

Each committee member serves as the point person on each campus for communication and dialogue about the Collaboration. Specifically activities include but are not limited to:

- creating new academic opportunities and ensuring that existing programs are impactful;
- setting the goals and processes for the distribution of Three College Innovation funds such as seed funding for new initiatives through either grants or

targeted opportunities;

- working with the administrative director (currently Joanne Kossuth of Olin) and support staff to organize the semi-annual retreats and other programs and activities of mutual interest to the three campuses;
- lowering barriers to doing activities across institutions: maintain clear channels for communication that enable efficient fixes for logistical problems that arise across institutions.

The Committee is made up of a faculty member from each campus selected by their respective provost, in consultation with the other two provosts, because of their passion and dedication to the Collaboration. The terms of appointment are set by mutual agreement. The Committee meets regularly with the provosts and administrative director to assure continuity and institutional support.

Innovation Grants 2014

As part of the Collaboration, the college presidents have established the **Presidential Innovation Project Fund**, which is available to the Babson, Olin, and Wellesley communities for projects that will enhance the BOW Three College Collaboration and the overall student educational experience.

The **Presidential Innovati on Grants** offer an opportunity for members of the BOW Three College Collaboration – faculty, staff, and students – to submit project proposals related to the enhancement of the collaboration. The number of pro-

jects funded and the amount of the awards will vary from year to year based on project merit and available budget. The majority of awards will likely total between \$500 and \$2,000 but in exceptional cases, awards of up to \$10,000 will be considered. The members of the BOW Faculty Steering Committee will assist in reviewing proposals and making recommendations on awards for approval by the college presidents.

PROPOSALS ARE DUE JANUARY 31, 2014.

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Requires participation from at least two of the colleges. Participation from all three is preferable.
- · Participation from multiple constituencies. Participation from faculty, staff, and students is preferable.
- · Impact on the BOW Three College Collaboration.
- · Self-contained nature of the projects (those that require on-going support will need to show other sources of support for continuation).
- Plan for assessment of project's outcome and dissemination of work.
